Training POLICIES



Policies

- Pre-registration is required for all classes.
- Registration and payment are required by the deadline specified on <https://registry.occrra.org>
- Registration will be accepted after the deadline via telephone, if seats are available. Walk-ins are welcome if space is available and trainer approves. Payment must be received before credit will be given.
- For classes that have a fee, registration will be considered complete once payment is received.
- Credit card payments will be accepted through the Ohio Professional Registry at the time of registration, or during call-in registration after the deadline. Cash and checks are also accepted, but at our Canton office only. **There will be a \$25 charge for any NSF check submitted.**
- Registration fees will be refunded if the student cancels before the deadline. No refund will be offered if the student either cancels after the deadline or registers but is absent from class. Substitutions are welcome with 24-hour notice, but refunds are unavailable.
- Classes may be cancelled due to low enrollment or weather conditions. Refunds will be issued in these instances.
- All listings are subject to change following publication. Please consult the Ohio Professional Registry for the most up-to-date information.
- **We no longer provide in-service forms.** All credit will be awarded in the Ohio Professional Registry.
- Attendees must arrive within 15 minutes after the start of a class session in order to receive credit. Attendees who arrive after the 15-minute grace period are welcome to stay, but will not receive credit for the class, workshop, or event.
- Every effort will be made to provide **reasonable accommodations** to individuals with a specific learning need or disability. Participants who require reasonable accommodations should notify the Early Childhood Resource Center of their need. All requests will be evaluated on an individual basis. A training and referral specialist will engage with the individual in a discussion about possible reasonable accommodations. Accommodation requests may be denied if they impose undue hardship on the Early Childhood Resource Center.
- **No children** are permitted in training classes at any time. This distracts the participants as well as the trainer and takes away from the learning experience for everyone.
